# Debate Competition

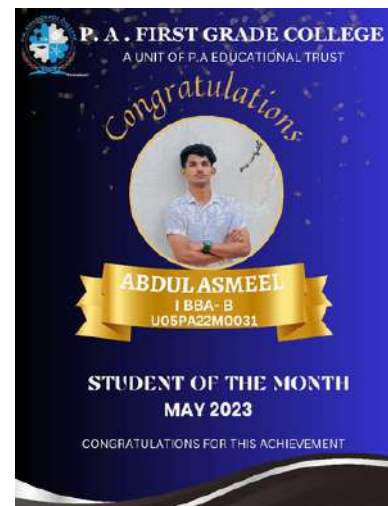

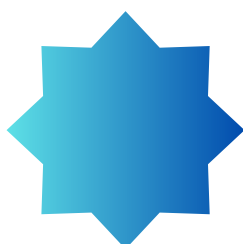
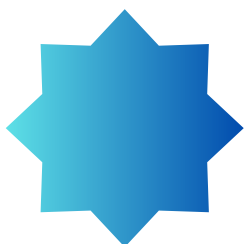
## Principal as Resource Person at Islahi School

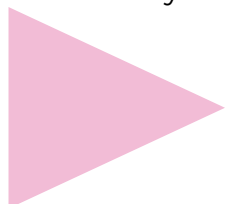

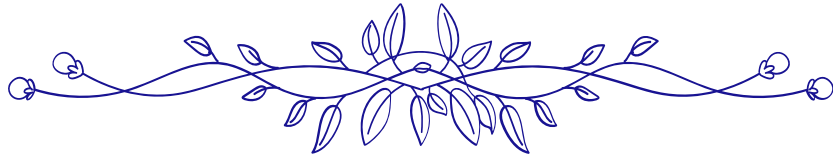
